Nomination and Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicants must be recommended by an SCA member who is in good standing with a Lifetime membership or has completed at least two (2) years of membership with one or more years of active membership remaining.
- Applicants must be related to the SCA member that nominates them. Related is defined as: spouse, child, grandchild, great-grandchild, sibling, child or grandchild of sibling. (Exceptions will be considered for those related members of former Army MSC officers who were killed in action or disabled in combat and retired from active duty for those disabling conditions.)
- A member may nominate one applicant no more than every two years.
- Applicants may receive a maximum of two awards.
- Applicants are not limited to high school seniors. They may be attending college at the time of application; an adult wanting to attend college for the first time or to continue their education after a break in attendance.

General:

- The SCA will award College Scholarships normally in the amount of \$1,000.00 each. The awards will be considered annually, and the number of awards will depend on the availability of Scholarship Funds.
- Applications must be submitted no later than the date indicated on the application.
- Scholarship awards are limited to applicants working on college credit at the undergraduate (BA/BS) level.
